On the job

Even after training, applying project management practices is a common challenge for many teams. As a means of support, we offer an on-the-job learning and consultation trajectory, custom made with one specific goal in mind – to make you and your team succeed. Ways of working

This support track consists of any combination of the following work methods:

- Personal sparring or coaching for the project leader
 - An individual single session to deal with questions, feeling stuck or to offer you advice and professional sparring.
 - A series of sessions for professional coaching on your role, personal style, or approach.
- Facilitation of project sessions by one of our facilitators:
 - Project Startup (PSU)
 - Project Followup Session (PFU)
 - Risk management sessions
 - Project evaluations
- Project Team coaching on collaboration, communication and/or performance.

Intake and design

Following the unique nature of projects and project-like assignments, it would be impossible to present a standardized outline. Therefore, the first step is always an individual intake meeting with the (prospected) project leader. During this meeting, we will assess the project challenge and design the trajectory together with you. Afterwards, you will have a clear idea of the steps and the required investment in time and hours.
